Objectives of the event:

This workshop aimed to spark the entrepreneurial spirit in the budding innovators by guiding them on how to convert their Innovative Ideas and emerge as successful Entrepreneurs. Becoming an entrepreneur is an important career decision, and to plunge into this domain requires the right skill set, attitude, and behaviour.

Mr. Ajit Kumar Shrivastava, Convenor IIC and Head of Department of Computer Science Engineering who is the moderator for this event started the session with a warm welcome to all the attendees, introduced the guest speaker.

The expert speaker shared with the students that the simple innovations which social entrepreneurs can do with the help of inventions of their time was also shared with students as these can have more impact on the society and its issues too. He further encouraged the students to follow their passion according to their skills.

The speaker highlighted some of the key characteristics of an entrepreneur, which are:

- Development of strategic thinking and scenario planning skills, as well as the ability to make intuitive decisions based on little knowledge.
- Stimulating a variety of entrepreneurial behaviours such as seeking for and seizing opportunities, networking, taking initiative, convincing others, and making intuitive decisions. This necessitates a diverse set of pedagogical tools.
- Empathy is instilled through entrepreneurial ideals and related "ways of thinking, doing, feeling, seeing, communicating, organizing, and learning things."

The speaker also answered all the queries of students in relation to how to identify ideas for start-ups, how to arrange funds, and how to develop social enterprises from scratch and still be able to earn profits to ensure sustainability of businesses in the long run.

Learning for the students:

To become an Entrepreneur, it is of utmost importance to have required skills and to simultaneously hone them to the required level as an entrepreneur faces a lot of situations in his day to day life where he has to use various skills to solve different problems encountered.

An entrepreneur must face rewards and rejection in the business and to deal with all those he has to have a right attitude and behaviour.
