YUKTI - National Innovation Repository (NIR): This is a new initiative of MoE's Innovation Cell to build innovation repositories in each and every higher educational institution as part of building YUKTI - National Innovation Repository (NIR). *The major role of IIC institutions is to create and build INNOVATION REPOSITORY at the institute level by identifying, scouting, and verifying ideas, innovations, and start-ups developed by students, recent graduates, alumni members, and faculty members, staff, and entrepreneurs who received incubation support from the institute. Further institutions will provide/offer various hand-holding supports on a continuous basis in terms of one-to-one mentoring, pre-incubation support, linkage with incubation unit, connection with Angel/VC investment, facilitating IP generation and technology Transfer, nominating for participation in national challenges, etc as per the*

requirement of applications. This scouring, verifying, and offering support will be a regular/round-the-year activity at the institute level.

MIC instructed all IIC Institutions to Create and Maintain a Repository of Innovations by Identifying, Scouting and Evaluating Innovations and Start-ups Developed by Faculty Members, Students, Alumni and Incubated Start-ups on Regular Basis.
